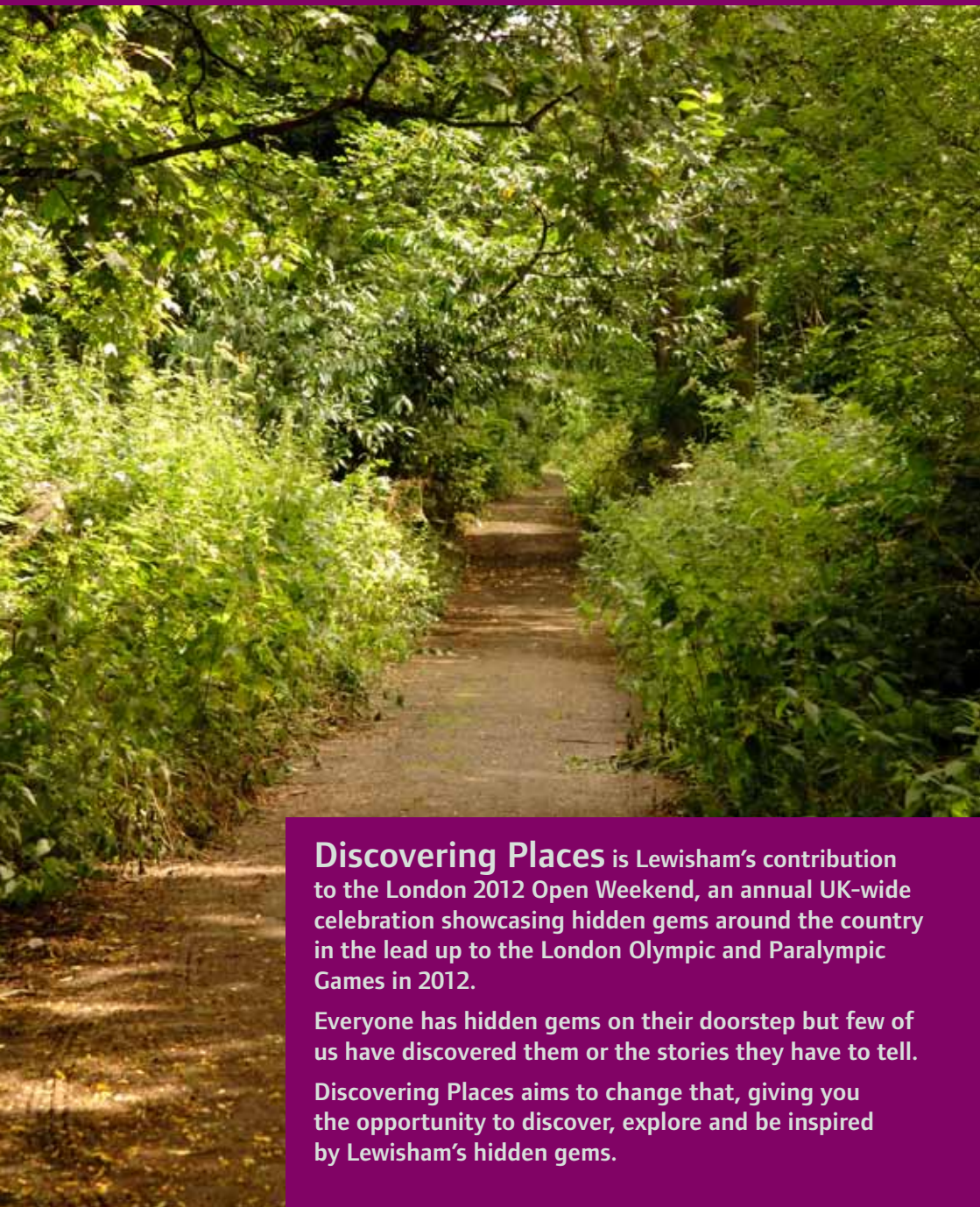


Discovering Places - Lewisham
